If you do not qualify for DSS assistance but are still in need of financial assistance, you must first attempt to go through DSS, receive a denial letter. Please bring the letter with other materials required for the Open Doors application.

YMCA Camp Hanes

Traditional Camp is divided into two different groups:

Climbers (ages 7-11) and Mountaineers (ages 12-14). A positive Christian setting is provided for campers at all times within their own age levels. Campers live in an 8-12 camper cabin with at least 2 well-trained, responsible camp staff. Programs are packed with age-appropriate activities like swimming, canoeing, zip lines and many more too numerous to list! Days are a balance of camper-selected and cabin-based activities designed to help foster growth physically, mentally, emotionally and spiritually in all participants. Our goal is for campers to leave with a deeper understanding of their own potential and a new collection of lifelong memories and friends.

Horses (all ages) and **Paintball** (10+) can both be added to the traditional camp program (for an additional fee.)

Adventure Camp, for ages 12-15, combines the best of traditional on-camp activities and off-site outdoor adventures. Campers will live in tents both while at Camp Hanes and while experiencing off-site activities like paddling, caving and hiking for part of the week. Each session is supervised by our trained and certified staff and is a great way for campers to take their summer to the next level!

Teen Camp is designed for campers ages 13-16 and offers an exciting blend of both adventure and traditional camp activities. Counselors will lead campers through activities challenging teens to go the "extra mile." Teen Campers' day will end later, include more activities and include a day trip.
